**345 Contract Torri Tyfiant ar Lwybrau**

- a) Dywedodd y Cadeirydd fod y cyfarfod  
wedi'i alw yn dilyn digwyddiad honedig a  
oedd yn cynnwys Mr Meurig Lloyd,  
contractwr y Cyngor, a'r Cynghorydd  
Caryl Vaughan a'i mam, ar ddydd  
Gwener 10fed Mai 2019.

Darllenodd y Cynghorydd Jones y  
gwybodaeth roedd hi wedi'i dderbyn gan  
y Cynghorydd Vaughan a darllenodd y  
Clerc y gwybodaeth roedd ef wedi'i  
dderbyn gan Meurig Lloyd.

Roedd yr Aelodau ar ddeall fod yr  
Heddlu yn gwneud ymholiadau am y  
digwyddiad a **PHENDERFYNWYD** felly,  
gan taw hwn oedd y sefyllfa, i beidio rhoi

- b) Cyfeiriodd y Cadeirydd at benderfyniad  
y Cyngor yn ei gyfarfod diwethaf, roedd  
Meurig Lloyd yn bresennol ynddo fe, ac  
a anfonwyd i Mr Lloyd mewn llythyr  
dyddiedig 13eg Mai, a ddarllenwyd gan  
y Clerc i'r Aelodau, a oedd yn  
cyfarwyddo Mr Lloyd:

**345 Footpath Growth Cutting Contract**

- a) The Chairman explained that the meeting  
had been called following an apparent  
incident involving Mr Meurig Lloyd, the  
Council's Contractor, and Councillor Caryl  
Vaughan and her mother on Friday 10<sup>th</sup>  
May 2019.

Councillor Jones read out the information  
she had received from Councillor  
Vaughan about the incident and the Clerk  
read out the information he had received  
from Meurig Lloyd.

Members understood that the Police were  
investigating the incident. It was therefore  
**RESOLVED** that, as this was the  
situation, not to consider the matter  
further.

- b) The Chairman referred to the decision of  
the Council at its last meeting, at which  
Mr Lloyd was present, and which had  
also been conveyed to Mr Lloyd by way  
of a letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> May which the Clerk  
read out to Members, which instructed Mr  
Lloyd:

- *not to cut growth on private land*

*preifat sydd pendraw i'r ffensys sy'n diffinio'r llwybrau cyhoeddus;*

- *yn dilyn y toriad cyntaf yma, i gyfyngu'r toriadau a wneir gennyh i docio tyfiant yn unig ac i beidio a gwneud toriadau llymach tan ddiwedd y tymor nythu*
- *i glirio a chymryd i ffwrdd y tyfiant a dorwyd gennyh.*

Yn dilyn trafodaeth, gan fod yna ddealltwriaeth fod y toriad cyntaf wedi'i gwblhau (ar wahan i ddarn o lwybr Neuadd yr Eglwys a oedd wedi'i adael yn dilyn y digwyddiad honedig), **PENDERFYNWYD** cyfarwyddo Mr Lloyd i beidio â pharhau gyda thoriadau pellach nes fod y Cyngor wedi derbyn cyngor ar y drefn gorau i dorri tyfiant ar lwybrau.

Daeth y cyfarfod i ben am 8:30 p.m.

*which lies the other side of the fences which define the public footpaths*

- *following this first cut, to restrict the cuts to be made by you to only trim growth and not to make any more severe cuts until the end of the nesting season*
- *to clear and take away the growth cut by you.*

Following discussion, as it was understood that the first cut had now been completed (save for a length of the Church Hall footpath which had been left following the alleged incident), it was **RESOLVED** to instruct Mr Lloyd not to proceed with further cuts until the Council had received advice on the correct procedure for cutting growth on footpaths.
