- 20 Future Meetings of the Council**  
 The programme of meetings for the 2022-23 municipal year was approved. Consideration was given to the request of Councillor Lodwick Lloyd that the Council revert to meeting in the Reading Room. Members felt that the current venue was more suitable for holding meetings. The Clerk referred to the requirement of the Local Government and Elections (Wales) Act 2021 for Councils to hold multi location meetings and that he knew of one Clerk who was holding meetings at the local Community Primary School as it contained resources to enable remote attendance to take place.  
 It was **RESOLVED** to continue to meet at the current location and to request the Clerk to contact the Headteacher of the Llannon County Primary School as to the possibility of using its hall for future meetings.
- 21 Any Other Competent Business**  
 County Councillor Keith Henson stated that he had attended a meeting earlier that day in respect of the proposal of the Welsh Government to replace 30 mph speed limits with 20 mph speed limits. It was noted that Town and Community Councils would be consulted on the proposals. Councillor Dennis Morgan stated that he had discussed matters relating to replacing dropped kerbs, clearing Morfa beach and the provision of a community noticebard at Stad Craog Ddu with Enzo's.
