**274 Salt Bins**

Consideration was given to the price received from the County Council for the provision of community salt bins, being £240 for the supply and delivery of full bins and an estimate of £150 for the future filling of bins in the future.

It was **RESOLVED:**

- i) to purchase six bins for use in the locations previously identified in the Community; and
- ii) to include provision in the 2024-25 budget for the cost of filling the bins.

**275 2024-25 Budget, Precept and Council Tax**

The Clerk presented his Report and detailed consideration was given to its contents.

In particular, the following matters were noted.

The playground extension would not proceed this year and an appropriate sum would need to be included in the Budget.

The Football Club would be contributing to the cost of cutting the playing field grass from now on.

The cost of filling the salt bins would need to be included.

Councillor Henson referred to discussions underway by the County Council in respect of its Budget and the possibility of this Council being requested to take responsibility for a particular service.

It was **RESOLVED:**
