453 Report of County Councillor Keith Henson

Councillor Henson reported as follows:

- he was dealing various case work
- he was continuing to follow up with Barcud and the Trunk Road Agency the placing of the defibrillator cases in the two bus shelters and also a sign for the Village Hall at the junction
- an increase of 9.3% had been set in the Council Tax for 2025-26 by the County Council. The Budget included additional finance for education, social services, planning enforcement (intended to be self-funding) and road improvements. No cuts in services were proposed.

454 Any Other Matter

Matters discussed:

- the need to follow up the judging of the material received in the planter design competition
- matters being followed up by the Chairman included dealing with the public footpath hedges and fences, finalising the location of the proposed salt bins and meeting with an officer of the National Grid in respect of an electricity supply for the storage shed.
